Bylaw Changes

It seems a bit ironic that you have to go to Article 67, in the Grand Lodge Bylaws, to determine membership classifications in the Order. In brief, members are classified as *Regular, Associate, Social, At-Large, Meritorious, Honorary and Junior.* For an organization that has been losing membership and lodges over the past numerous years it is time we stopped putting our members into boxes and discriminating against those who may not be of Italian descent, choose the death benefit or of a certain age when they join.

Our country has gone through a period of DEI (Diversity, Equity and Inclusion) and yet we see the Order do the exact opposite when it comes to dividing our membership into different categories. We must remember the tenets of the Order are *LIBERTY-EQUALITY-FRATERITY* We need to change Article 67 to combine Regular, Associate and Social into one classification. *REGULAR* members.

Roma Lodge was founded 95 years ago with its primary mission of getting Italian Immigrants to become American Citizens. That mission has changed to one of carrying on the Italian Culture. You don't have to be Italian to want to do that. You may have friends who are Italian, enjoy Italian food, like to volunteer at Roma Lodge fundraising activities like the WAE food booth or ravioli dinner drive-thru or just have fun. If you want to join Roma Lodge you should be a Regular member. **PERIOD!**
