# Passing the Torch



wish I had a dollar for every time one of our long time Roma Lodge members has said to me, "I have put in my time for Roma Lodge and I'm too old and tired to do that anymore!" I would be rich!

I joined Roma Lodge on March 2, 1956 at the ripe old age of 9. Now, some 68 years later I will be enter-

ing my 5th term as your president, if so duly elected at our March meeting. Mario Bruno was elected the first president of Roma Lodge back in 1930 and the lodge has had 35 members who have served as



president of which only 8 are still with us. Of these 35 presidents only two

have been women. *Olivia Lerda-Goni* who served 3 terms (1987-1992) and *Kathy Briano* who served in 1995-1996.

If you look at the Grand Lodge and Roma Lodge bylaws it states *a president shall not serve more than 3 consecutive 2-year terms*. The caveat of this bylaw is that one can serve more than three consecutive terms if no one else wishes to take over the position of president.

So, I guess you are stuck with me for the next two years, if I live that long. However, unlike my previous terms of office, this will definitely be my last. It *is time to pass the torch* to others who would like to take a leadership role in carrying on our Italian Culture.

America's new president has been accused of being a threat to democracy and instituting a oligarchy form of government where a small group of people control a country, organization or institution. It has been suggested this is the way I choose to conduct Roma Lodge activities. It is time to pass some of these duties on to others. During my next term I plan to pass many of these activities on to those who choose to help.

# In 2025 the lodge has these major activities:

- February-WAE food booth which is one of our major fundraising activities. Thankfully, Michael DePaoli, Melissa Watkins and Maci Daramy serve as our chairs. It is time for someone to step forward and take over as chairs for this event next year and learn from them this year.
- May-95th Anniversary of the Lodge. Unless we have someone volunteer to serve as chair for the anniversary, select a committee to organize the event and select a date and venue we will continue with our usual celebration at our May meeting like we do every year.
- June-We have not had a formal declaration in writing from the Grand Council concerning our designation as a lodge in default so we will have to decide if we will send representation to the Grand Lodge Convention.
- July-Since we did not have our traditional Columbus
   Day Celebration in October do we want to have a bocce tournament and BBQ in July? We do not have a meeting in July. We need a



chair who would like to take on this activity.

- October-Our ravioli dinner drive-thru during Columbus Day weekend. We need a chairperson to organize and conduct this event. We had a great start this past year and should build on this tradition of letting the public know about Roma Lodge and our Italian Culture.
- December-Our annual XMAS party is always a big event and great for our Junior members. Leslie DePaoli has done a wonderful job of serving as our chair. If you would like to help, contact Leslie.

I'm always pleased with the number of members who step forward and help with our various activities. However, we need more individuals who want to take more of a leadership role and become chairs of these events. I'm here to help transition to others and assist them to organize and conduct these events.

#### Election of Officers-March 10, 2025

s outlined in the Grand Lodge bylaws a local lodge shall have nominations for local officers at the November meeting in even years and election of officers in December and installation of officers at the January meeting.

Unfortunately, we have missed both of those calendar dates and since we have already had our January meeting and our February meeting will be at the farm show, we will not have our nominations, elections and installation of our 2025-2026 slate of officers until our March meeting.

Another issue is that our meeting place, the WAE Social Hall, will not be available on March 3rd so our March meeting will



be March 10th. If we have multiple candidates for a particular office we will have open nominations from the floor of potential candidates and have a written ballot voting process. I will be asking former past presidents who are present at the meeting to count the ballots. If you plan to run for office you will need someone at the meeting to nominate you for the office you are seeking.

If we do not have multiple candidates for any office we will ask for a motion to accept the slate of officers and cast a unanimous ballot. *See you March 10th.* 

#### Paying Your Dues for 2025!

Roma Lodge dues were due starting January 1, 2024. At the January meeting the lodge members voted to keep our dues at \$85 per year.
