

#### **Decision Time!**

Grand Lodge, OSDIA and Roma Lodge dues were due on January 1, 2023. Below are the breakdown of where your \$75 dues goes:


As you can see only \$.25 cents of your dues goes to Roma Lodge. If you are paying your dues thinking you are supporting Roma Lodge we only get a small portion of the dues you pay. With the pandemic and loss of revenue from our fundraisers it may become necessary in the future to raise our dues. Each person and family will need to decide if they want to continue their membership for 2023.

We ask everyone to pay their dues by March 31, 2023 or we will have to drop your membership. Roma Lodge has to pay the Grand Lodge and OSDIA dues quarterly. Therefore, the lodge cannot support members who do not pay their dues on time.
