In May of 1930 Italian Immigrants, who settled in Tulare County, came together to form Roma Lodge. Meeting at the Tulare Women's Club House, which still sits on E. Tulare Avenue, 115 charter members were initiated into the lodge.

Now, some 95 years later we need to come together to celebrate their accomplishments as we have many members today, whose parents and grandparents were part of those charter members.




