The Pitigliano Family has been farming in Tulare County since 1920 when Charlie's great grandfather *Ben Lapadula* started growing and packing potatoes in the Porterville area. Charlie started his own farming oper-

ation in 1975 and along with his family farms or manages over 12,000 acres of almonds, pistachios, grapes and citrus.

helping in anyway they can to reduce the impact of the flooding. It is going to take a long time for Tulare County to recover from all the damage created by this 100-year flood.

Grand Lodge, OSDIA and Roma Lodge dues were due on January 1, 2023. Roma Lodge must




