Presidents Message

e all know that October is one of the busiest months of the year. For the children, school is back in session, football, soccer and baseball are in full swing, back-to-school events, Halloween, Fall Harvests and a variety of other events are going on. *Everyone is super busy!*

So why does Roma Lodge have a meeting, Columbus Day Celebration and a ravioli dinner fundraiser all in October?

Well let's start with *Christoper Columbus* himself. Mr. Columbus discovered America on October 12, 1492 when a sailor on board the Pinta




sighted land. The rest is history. This is why America celebrates Columbus Day on the second Monday of October. It became a federal holiday in 1937 and since the 1990's has been replaced by many states as Indigenous People's Day. I will let all of you decide the merits of that decision.



October was also designated *National Italian-American Heritage* month by the United States Congress in 1989. Therefore, Italian immigrants were

designated a month when many other ethnic groups have not been so recognized.

In 2021 the Tulare City Council and Mayor Dennis Mederos designated Italian Heritage Month for the City of Tulare to commemorate the contributions of those of Italian descent to the Tulare community.



For the past 85 years nothing lets the community know more about Roma Lodge than our annual ravioli dinner. The pandemic of 2020 prevented the



lodge from having a dinner through 2022 and now it is time to bring it back.

For over 20 years the dinner was held on Mother's Day weekend. As attendance waned for sit down diners, and those who wanted to dance. The lodge adapted to changing times and decided to have a drive-thru only event. Members often complained about the Mother's Day weekend event because lodge mothers, who spent several hours working the dinner were often too tired to do much the next day. The weather was often hot and moving the event to the IAC Social Hall will make dinner preparation much easier.

Decision Time!


Before we know it January-2024 will be here and once again time to pay your Roma Lodge dues. We have discussed at our September and October
