
ways nice to hear what other lodges are doing.

The Grand Lodge convention will be held June 22-



24th in Reno Nevada at the Silver Legacy Hotel and Casino. Roma Lodge will be sending two delegates to this years convention. Sending only two delegates will still cost the lodge over \$2,000 (as compared to over \$5,000 if we had to send 5 delegates as

required by Grand Lodge bylaws) which is a large expense for the lodge. It is time the Grand Lodge considers reducing the number of days of the convention, the number of delegates required by local lodges and the way the conventions are being conducted. Status Quo no longer works!

I'm entering my 4th term as your Roma Lodge president. I first served the organization as president in 1999-2000. In 2001 I took over writing the newsletter. With the help of my mother-in-law Lupe Briano we entitled the publication the LeNotizie, Italian for *The News*. Now, over 250 publications later, the LeNotizie has documented Roma Lodge activities for the past 20+ years.

Over the years technology has changed, so writing the newsletter no longer takes a typewriter Joanne Beecher had to use. Cutting and pasting articles out of the newspaper is no longer needed because local newspapers do not print activities of local

clubs and organizations. Long time Historian Pierina **Girado** did a wonderful job of putting together scrapbooks to document lodge activities. You now can go to the Tulare Public Library to view those scrapbooks to learn more about Roma Lodge.

As your president I have three goals for the organization.

- Emphasize the tenet of fraternity by holding a monthly meeting with a dinner to be enjoyed by member families.
- 2. Conduct the business session of the meetings in a prompt and efficient manner.
- 3. Focus on the *family* by having junior member activities at each meeting so families can enjoy a great meal and have an educational activity for the junior members while the business meeting is going on. (Thank you *Pam Sola*)

We have been deficit spending the last couple of years due to the pandemic with the loss of our annual ravioli dinner. Therefore, we need to have another fundraiser by the end of the year so we can keep our finances solvent. If you have other ideas of how we can make the lodge experience better for our members, let me know.

I'm not advocating an Italian Festival in downtown Tulare or a parade honoring Christopher Columbus. I think we keep doing what we are doing so the "Status Quo" may not be so bad after all!
