In Due Time!

It has been 7 years since the Grand Lodge of California increased their dues by \$10 forcing Roma Lodge to increase their dues to \$75 in 2015. January is the time we all have to make a decision as to whether or not we are going to continue to be Roma Lodge members for the upcoming year. The chart below shows where your \$75 goes.

With the sale of the Grand Lodge building it appears that the Grand Lodge is solvent and will not be increasing their dues anytime soon. As a lodge we voted last April we would only be sending 3 delegates (allocated 6 based on membership) with no alternates to the 2022 convention in Anaheim. We notified the Grand Lodge of our decision in May so they had plenty time to adjust their convention budget and numbers to reflect our decision. At the convention our bylaw change to do away with fines passed.

In November we received a letter indicating the Grand Lodge would be fining us \$1,800 for only having 3 delegates. We have asked whether or not the 8 lodges with no representation and countless other lodges with partial representation were also fined. We are awaiting notification.

Financially, Roma Lodge remains solvent, however, without our major ravioli dinner, as a fundraiser, we have been in deficit spending the last 3 years since the pandemic. We have two options. Either raise our dues or put on more fundraising activities to show a positive cashflow at the end of the year.

Bring your checks for your dues to the February meeting, however, leave them blank until we decide what our 2023 dues will be. We will make a decision at the February 6th meeting. Stay tuned!
