Looking on the Brightside!

The *LeNotizie* for September was headed to the printer with my Herald's Message lamenting the lack of participation by members at lodge activities. I had went through my directory scouring through each page of names and trying to remember if I had seen this person or that person at a meeting, Christmas Party, ravioli dinner, farm show food booth or Columbus Day Celebration.

A cursory look on each page quickly had me writing numbers of people I had seen the past year at lodge activities. There were only 2 on this page, 9 on that page and another 11 on the page after that. Now, I was on to something. By my count there were only 131 members I had remembered seeing at some event. Only 131 out of 302! A mere 43.3%!

I quickly opened up a spreadsheet and calculated the net return on a person's \$75 dues and determined for a family of four if you attended all the lodge meetings, parties, dinners and farm show you would net over \$1,402 on your investment. How could this be that only 43.3% of our members ever show up at lodge activities!

I was all excited and shared the article with my wife who quickly reminded me that it would be too negative and I should write something else. So I went back to my directory to scan the names one more time. Yup, 302 names are listed as Roma Lodge members.

I soon found out that some of these people live in Arroyo Grande, this person in Idaho, that one in Ohio, another family in Stockton, these people were at the meeting and they live in Bakersfield! The list was filled with dozens of families who do not live in Tulare County. In fact 92 of our members live outside of Tulare County. No wonder they cannot attend all lodge activities.

Then I quickly looked at my Excel database of lodge member statistics. We have 30 members over 80 years of age, 33 between 70 and 79 and 44 between 60-69 for a total of 107 or a 1/3 of our members over 60! I'm sure many of these members can only attend a few lodge activities per year and some none at all because of age or illness.

We have almost another 1/3 (84) members who are between the ages of 30 and 50 and we know they are super busy with children activities and school so it is very difficult for them to attend lodge meetings on

school nights and have many other activities during the weekend. So figuring we have nearly 100 members who live outside of Tulare County, another 107 over the age of 60 and 84 who are probably busy parents between the ages of 30 and 50 then to get 50 members at a meeting or other activity is pretty good all things considered.

So, I have decided to look on the bright side and bring you some Sunshine News! Sunshine News can be defined as good news that makes one happy or to have someone in your life that

brings joy and happiness to others.

I know when I attend Roma Lodge meetings a person who brings sunshine into my life is seeing our State Deputy *Lilia Giacomazzi*. Lilia represents all the best of our Italian Culture and has a



long, long history of service to the Order and has given so much of herself and her resources to Roma Lodge and the Hanford Lodge over the years. She has had a few setbacks with her health lately and we all wish her a rapid recovery and cannot wait to see her at

future meetings.

Charlie Pitigliano brings a lot of sunshine to peoples lives and has done so much for Roma Lodge over the years. He is going to be honored by the COS Foundation as an inductee into their Hall of
