Angel Among Us!

oma Lodge members were all saddened with the passing of *Lilia* Curti Giacomazzi, our Roma Lodge State Deputy, who passed away on December 22, 2018. Lilia was initiated into the Roma Lodge #1573 on February 7, 1936 and was our oldest member at 105 years of age and an 82-year member of our lodge.



Her father, *Miro Curti*, was president of Roma Lodge from 1936-1939. Lilia transferred her membership to the Hanford Lodge when she married her husband *Fred Giacomazzi* on July 12, 1936. Lilia served as the State Deputy for the Roma Lodge for nearly 40 years.

Lilia always held a special place in her heart for Roma Lodge. She would faithfully attend lodge meetings, initiate new members, install officers and conduct other official protocols for the lodge. She would always come prepared with her beautiful handwritten notes, ensuring she would not miss the smallest detail about who to thank, those to be congratulated, or as always, how much she enjoyed an activity or fundraiser of the

Lilia took her role as State Deputy very seriously and always cautioned lodge officers to fulfill their duties with attention to detail in conducting ceremonies with



the proper pomp and circumstance befitting the organization. Everything she did was with the upmost class and dignity as she fulfilled her duties as State Deputy.

During the holiday season, when the airways are filled with Christmas music, one of my favorite songs has always been the country group Alabama's song entitled Angels Among Us. The lyrics tell the story of a boy, on a cold winter day, who took a shortcut through the woods, got lost and was taken home by an Angel.

The chorus goes,

Oh I believe there are angels among us Sent down to us from somewhere up above They come to you and me in our darkest hours To show us how to live, to teach us how to give To guide us with the light of love.

I believe God put Lilia Giacomazzi on this earth for the past 105 years as an Angel Among Us! Lilia was a woman of strong faith. It was her faith that gave her the strength each day to accept the challenges God put in front of her. She dealt with them, and moved on with her life. Like most of us she suffered many tragedies with the loss of a husband, son, grandson and nephews. Instead of being the one who sought solace in others to share her grief, others pursued her to comfort them in their hour of sorrow.

If you had the opportunity to attend Lilia's services each and every speaker spoke of her kindness, caring, compassion for others, charity, leadership and positive attitude.

Her "Casa de Tutti ("House for All") was always open with a welcoming smile, a good meal and a place to spread ones joy and happiness. It was also a house that became a sanctuary for those who sought reassurance when their lives had suffered tradedy.

Like an Angel she was a great listener as she patiently heeded what was being said without judgement. Saving her comments until they would do the most good for the person seeking her advice.

As in the song, she "showed us how to live, taught us how to give and certainly guided us with the light of love." She did all of this while keeping her favorite song in her mind and singing from her lips, "You Are My Sunshine" which was always sung at her birthday parties. The sun shines a little less today with her passing.

She will now take on a new role in our lives and become an angel in spirit to many of us who will remember her charm and grace who served as a role model for all of us on how best to live our lives. Farewell Sister Lilia!
